



BOF Spotlight: Gala Host Stephanie Blythe

Berkshire Opera Festival is delighted to bring mezzo-soprano **Stephanie Blythe**, winner of the 2019 Maria Callas Award, to host our Fifth Anniversary Gala Concert.



Ms. Blythe is one of the most highly respected and critically acclaimed artists of her generation. She has performed in many of the renowned opera houses in the US and Europe including the Metropolitan Opera, San Francisco Opera, Lyric Opera of Chicago, Seattle Opera, Royal Opera House Covent Garden, and Opéra National de Paris.

Her many roles include the title roles in *Carmen*, *Samson et Dalila*, *Orfeo ed Euridice*, *La Grande Duchesse*, *Tancredi*, *Mignon*, and *Giulio Cesare*; Frugola, Principessa, and Zita in *Il Trittico*, Fricka in both *Das Rheingold* and *Die Walküre*, Waltraute in *Götterdämmerung*, Azucena in *Il Trovatore*, Ulrica in *Un Ballo in Maschera*, Baba the Turk in *The Rake's Progress*, Ježibaba in *Rusalka*, Jocasta in *Oedipus Rex*, Mère Marie in *Dialogues des Carmélites*; Mistress Quickly in *Falstaff*, and Ino/Juno in *Semele*.

Ms. Blythe also created the role of Gertrude Stein in Ricky Ian Gordon's *27* at the Opera Theatre of Saint Louis and sang performances of Ms. Lovett in *Sweeney Todd* at the San Francisco Opera and Nettie Fowler in *Carousel* at the Houston Grand Opera and with the New York Philharmonic. She was named Musical America's Vocalist of the Year for 2009 and received the 2007 Opera News Award and the 1999 Richard Tucker Award.

Locally, Ms. Blythe uses her talents to promote young artists. She is the Artistic Director of the Fall Island Vocal Arts Seminar at the Crane School of Music in Potsdam, NY, and in 2019 she was appointed as the Director of the Bard College Conservatory of Music Graduate Vocal Arts Program in Red Hook, NY.
